To prevent electrocution switch off at the mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electrical supply without your knowledge. If you are in any doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.

If replacing an existing fitting, make a careful note of the connections.

This light should be connected to a circuit with a 30mA RCD fitted.

This product contains non-replaceable parts and cannot be serviced. If damages occurs the part should be scrapped.

Layout

Plan the desired layout of these fittings carefully, ensuring the cables will reach the distances between the junction box and the each light fitting.

Avoid locating any cables in positions that would cause a hazard. Position cables and outdoor rated junction boxes (not supplied) away from areas where they may be at risk from being cut, trapped or damaged.

We recommend that you use H05RN-F specification cable (not supplied) which is an outdoor grade, rubber sheathed cable.

The mains supply cable must have a minimum cross section area of 1.0mm².


Cables must be protected using suitable conduit or plastic trunking.

Installation

Existing fittings must be completely removed before installation of a new product. Before removing the existing fitting, carefully note the position of each set of wires.


Note that the switch is turned off before installation.

- Undo the screws at the top and bottom of the shade to detach if from the wall back (Fig. 1)
- Loosen the screws at the bottom of the LED board.
 Slide the board down and detach from the wall back to access the terminal block (Fig. 2)
- Decide which cable entry hole to use -the hole at the rear of the wall back - or the conduit entry hole at the base. Drill out where necessary and fit the cable grommet before pulling the supply wiring through. (Fig. 3)
- Using the wall back as template mark and drill the fixing holes. Attach the wall back to the wall. Ensure the wall is capable of taking the weight of the product. Take care not to damage any concealed wiring or pipes.
- · Wire as detailed below



Wiring

Having correctly identified the wiring from your existing light fitting, connect to the connection block inside the product in the following way:



Check that...

- You have correctly identified the wires.
- . The connections are tight.
- · No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.

Commissioning

- Refit the LED board in place.
- · Refit the shade.
- Replace fuse or circuit breaker and switch on. Your light is now ready for use.
